In your YourGLS "Address book" you have the possibility to import an address file with the data of your consignees. Thus the addresses of your customers are automatically available to you if you want to generate a parcel order.

To import an address file proceed as follows:

1. Select button "Import" in "Address book".

An address file with the data of your consignees can be imported here. The addresses of your consignees are thus available to you if you want to generate a parcel order.

2. Enter any delimiter in the field "Delimiter".

Use the delimiter that you have used in your import file e.g. comma (,), semicolon (;), colon (:), beam disk (|), hyphen (-). Do not use spaces.

3. Select the button "Select File".

Select the file you want to import. Note that the address file must be a text file (ASCII encoded). Formats such as CSV and TXT can be used.

1) Recommendation: "BlockNo" should be entered in a separate field, independent of "Street".

3) For Ireland, enter the Eircode (postal code in Ireland), the routing key (first three alphanumeric characters of the Eircode) or the location. The Eircode consists of a three-digit routing key and a unique identifier consisting of 4 alphanumeric characters.
